Students who are not able to attend **all** competitions will be able to perform in the recital but may not be able to compete. Choreography is set to specific patterning and sometimes partnering depending on the number of students in the routine. We do not have the ability to fill in the spot with other students. Having students missing, causes much stress and panic for the children. In addition, dancers with more than 5 unexcused absences from class may not be allowed to compete.
